



Can Patients Become Reinfected?


- Reports of re-infection:
 - Likely false negative test at hospital discharge.
- Other coronaviruses may reinfect after many months or years.
- Study among primates showed the animals did not become infected after re-exposure to SARS-CoV-2.
- Reinfection is highly unlikely.



Should Everyone Wear a Mask in Public?


Currently, CDC does not recommend routine use of medical masks among healthy individuals. (Based on study of flu prevention).

- A review study showed a mask, <u>WITH</u> handwashing, prevented SARS-CoV-1 infection.
- Because SARS-CoV-2 can be transmitted without symptoms, there is value in the use of masks.



How Does SARS-CoV-2 Spread?


- SARS-CoV-2 transmitted through droplets.
- Person-to-person transmission: coughing, sneezing, and talking.
- Droplets on objects last up to 9 days.
- Aerosolized particles can transfer during medical procedures.



When Will a Vaccine Be Available?

- A vaccine against SARS-CoV-2 is the ultimate strategy for controlling this pandemic.
- 3 vaccine candidates are currently in phase 1 human trials.
 - Estimated availability vaccine is early to mid-2021.



Georgia-7,558 confirmed cases, 294 (3.89%)


- 1 week ago- 3,032 confirmed cases, 102 deaths (3.36%)

- EVERYONE is contributing and partnering together
 - Sagal Radio, resettlement agencies, nonprofits, local companies
- Increasing response from government (local, state and national)
- DeKalb County and Clarkston have shelter-in-place orders
- Increasing hospital capacity- minimizing elective procedures

How to talk to kids about

COVID-19

1. Care for yourself!



- 2. Do NOT pretend it does not exist/avoid talking about it
- 3. DO use developmentally appropriate language.
 - -let your child ask questions
 - -don't volunteer too much information
- 4. "Let Bobby be Bobby."-take cues from your child (not your own feelings)-validate feelings and reassure children


