





Ethne Update



National- 160,881 confirmed cases, 2,975 deaths (1.85%)

1 week ago - 43,666 confirmed cases, 533 deaths (1.22%)

2 weeks ago- 4,032 confirmed cases, 79 deaths (1.96%)


Georgia- 3,032 confirmed cases, 102 deaths (3.36%)

1 week ago- 800 confirmed cases, 26 deaths (3.25%)

2 weeks ago - 121 confirmed cases, 1 death (0.82%)

Clarkston- at least 6 confirmed cases

Ethne Update



- Ability to test increasing but still limited (work in progress)
- EVERYONE is contributing and partnering together
 - Sagal Radio, resettlement agencies, nonprofits, local companies
- Increasing response from government (local, state and national)
- DeKalb County and Clarkston have shelter-in-place orders
- Atlanta and Stone Mountain have testing centers (limited)
- Increasing hospital capacity- minimizing elective procedures
